19 20 21 22	Further amend the Bill in section 4 in that part designated "§602-A." by striking out all of subsection 2 (page 3, lines 18 to 27 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

Notwithstanding sections 601 and 602, the county officers may decide to abolish the position of elected register of deeds and replace it with an appointed register of deeds. This decision shall not be effective until approved by the voters of the county under the procedures set forth in subsection 6.
30 31 32	Further amend the Bill in section 4 in that part designated "§602-A." by striking out all of subsection 6 and inserting in its place the following:
33 34 35 36	'6. Election procedure. Within 30 days after a decision under subsection 2 or the receipt of a certificate or final determination of sufficiency under subsection 5, the county officers shall by order

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т	submit the question of the abolition of the position
2	of elected register of deeds and its replacement with
