Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

P&SL 1895, c. 220, §5 is enacted to read:

Sec. 5. The Forks is authorized to raise and appropriate tax dollars to be awarded as educational scholarships to residents who have gained admission to, or who are currently enrolled in, approved post-secondary schools. Post-secondary schools include, but are not limited to, the state university system, any recognized degree-granting college or university, approved vocational schools which offer programs in secretarial, business, medical, dental, electrical or technical skills, including, but not limited to, state vocational-technical institutes.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
