22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
23 follows:

24 Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2104, sub-§2, as enacted by PL
25 1977, c. 622, is repealed and the following enacted
26 in its place:

27 2. Shipping papers. Shipping papers are pre-
28 pared in accordance with 49 Code of Federal Regula-
29 tions, Subpart C, Sections 172.200 to 172.204 and ac-
30 company the hazardous material in accordance with 49
31 Code of Federal Regulations, Subpart C, Section
32 177.817. This requirement shall apply to both intra-
33 state and interstate carriers.
