AN ACT to Adjust Certain Motor Vehicle
Title Fees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:

Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §2352, sub-§1, ¶¶B and C, as
repealed and replaced by PL 1981, c. 698, §134, are
amended to read:

(1) For filing an application for a first
certificate of title including security
interest;

(2) For filing notice of a security inter-
est after the first certificate of title has
been issued;

6 (1) For a corrected certificate of title or
7 certificate of salvage; and

11 Sec. 2. Allocation. The following funds are
12 allocated from the Highway Fund to carry out the pur-
13 poses of this Act.
