Bill, "AN ACT Creating a Maine Milk Pool."

Amend the Bill in section 4 in that part designated "§3152." by striking out all of subsection 9 and renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.

Further amend the Bill in section 4 in that part designated "§3153." in subsection 3 in the 2nd line (page 7, line 19 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "producer-dealer" the following: 'and northern Maine market producer'

Further amend the Bill in section 4 in that part designated "§3153." by striking out all of subsection 4 and inserting in its place the following:

'4. Redistribution of pool. The commissioner shall, by rule, adopt such procedures as are necessary to redistribute the Maine Milk Pool on an equal basis to all Maine market producers and Boston market producers, excepting:

A. If any Boston market producer receives a plant price, excluding deductions or additions imposed by the so-called Louisville Plan as defined by Part 1001 Federal Milk Order No. 1 Section 1001.61, Subsections c and d, or any amendment thereto, or imposed by any other seasonal balancing plan subsequently adopted by Federal Order No. 1, which is an amount greater than the amount initially payable to Maine market producers under subsection 2, the commissioner shall credit that additional amount against the redistribution from the Maine Milk Pool to which that producer would otherwise be entitled in

1 order to avoid potential inequities arising from
2 equal redistribution; and

3 B. Should the commissioner determine that pay-
4 ments from the pool will be made to dairies,
5 cooperatives or some other entity as a repre-
6 sentative of producers, then the dairy,
7 cooperative or other representative shall pay to
8 the producer the amount owed to that producer
9 within such time period as shall be determined by
10 the procedures established by rule under this
11 section.

12 Further amend the Bill in section 4 by striking
13 out all of that part designated "§3154."

14 Further amend the Bill in section 4 in that part
15 designated "§3155." in subsection 2 by striking out
16 all of the first paragraph (page 10, lines 7 to 9 in
17 L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:

18 '2. Deductions. Prior to the redistribution of
19 the pool as provided in section 3153, the commis-
20 sioner shall deduct the following:

7 Based on the higher costs of milk production, due
8 to higher costs for transportation, grain and other
9 inputs to dairy farming, in the areas of the State
10 which are geographically distant from the Boston
11 market, this amendment deletes portions of the bill
12 relating to the Northern Maine Milk Pool.
