2 3 4 5	This amendment deletes the delay in filing an application for involuntary admission which would be caused by not counting Saturdays, Sundays and holidays.
6 7 8 9	Further, the applicable standard for evaluating risk of nonphysical harm is made objective rather than subjective, and uses language found in the Child Protection Act.
10 11 12	Finally, this amendment requires that the courts act expeditiously on these matters, within 10 days of the filing of the application.
