SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 626, L.D. 1764,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Revise the General Assistance Laws."

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§4309." in subsection 2 in the 8th line (page 9, line 6 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "determination" the underlined word 'of'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§4316." in subsection 1 in lines 9 to 13 by striking out all of the last underlined sentence (page 15, lines 17 to 21 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following: 'An applicant is further ineligible for assistance for 60 days if he quits work after an initial application without just cause, or willfully fails to perform or willfully performs below average standards the job assigned under subsection 4 without just cause.'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§4323." in subsection 3 in the 2nd line (page 23, line 6 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined word "persons" and inserting in its place the underlined words 'a person'
