HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 629, L.D. 1769,
Bill, "AN ACT to Delay the Effective Date of the
Property Tax Exemption for Naturally Occurring Metal-
lic Minerals."

Amend the Bill in section 4 in subsection 4-A,
paragraph A by striking out all of the last line
(page 3, line 4 in L.D.) and inserting in its place
the following: 'the notice by the owner of the min-
erals.'

Further amend the Bill in section 7 in the 2nd
paragraph in the 3rd and 4th line (page 4, lines 3
and 4 in L.D.) by inserting after the words "from
taxation" the words 'of minerals'

Further amend the Bill in section 7 in the 3rd
paragraph in the 3rd line (page 4, line 16 in L.D.)
by striking out the words "expanded exemption" and
inserting in their place the following: 'exemption
for unextracted minerals'

Further amend the Bill in section 7 in the last
paragraph by striking out all of the first sentence
(page 5, lines 4 to 9 in L.D.) and inserting in its
place the following: 'The Legislature believes that,
should the proposed amendments not be approved by the
voters, careful consideration would have to be given
to changes in certain provisions of the mining excise
tax scheme to assure fulfillment of the purposes of
that law and to insure that mining companies would
not be subject to double taxation on minerals.'
