23 Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
24 lature do not become effective until 90 days after
25 adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

26 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate
27 until after the beginning of the next fiscal year;
28 and

29 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses inci-
30 dent to the operation of state departments and insti-
31 tutions will become due and payable before July 1st;
32 and

33 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
34 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of

1 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
2 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
3 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
4 therefore,

5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
6 follows:

7 Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §1005, sub-§6-A is enacted to
8 read:

9 6-A. Proceeds from disposal or sale of prop-
10 erty. Proceeds received by the authority from the
11 disposal, by sale or in some other means, of property
12 it may have acquired in accordance with section 1025
13 shall be credited either to the Mortgage Insurance
14 Fund, the Guarantee Reserve Fund, the Debt Service
15 Fund or the General Fund unappropriated surplus as
16 directed by the State Controller.

17 This provision shall take effect on June 30, 1983.

18 Sec. 2. Authority. Authority is given to the
19 State Controller to transfer \$2,152,233 from the
20 Group Life Insurance Fund to the General Fund to be
21 effective June 30, 1983.

22 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency
23 cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect
24 when approved.

25 STATEMENT OF FACT

26 The purpose of this bill is reflected in the
27 emergency preamble.

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
