Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

5 FISCAL NOTE

6 This bill appropriates the \$210,000 Sohio funds  
7 for public transportation and the Ride Share Program  
8 and the \$700,000 federal refund for energy conserva-  
9 tion loans, low income weatherization and energy  
10 related emergency crisis intervention.

11 STATEMENT OF FACT

12 The State of Maine has received \$210,000 from the  
13 Sohio Oil Company and \$700,000 from the Federal Gov-  
14 ernment as part of a federal settlement regarding  
15 alleged overcharges. These funds were placed in the  
16 General Fund Undedicated Revenue Suspense Account.  
17 Therefore, the appropriation requested in this bill  
18 will not affect the General Fund's current revenues.
