Whereas, Acts of the Legis-15 lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 16 Whereas, Legislative Document 1777, which was passed by the Legislature during the First Regular Session of the 111th Legislature, has been recalled 17 18 19 from the Governor's desk for reconsideration this 20 21 session; and 22 Whereas, certain provisions of that bill relating 23 to finance and discipline are immediately necessary 24 for the proper operation of state military affairs; 25 and Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 26 27 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 28 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 29 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-30 vation of the public peace, health and safety, now, 31 therefore, 32 Further amend the amendment by striking out all 33 of the first paragraph after the title and inserting 34 in its place the following: 35 'Further amend the bill in section 2, in para-

1 2 HOUSE AMENDMENT " To HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1337, L.D. 1777 graph D, by striking out all of subparagraph (12) (page 3, lines 31 to 33 in L.D.) and inserting in its 1 2 3 place the following: 4 (12) He may adopt rules pertaining to compliance with state and federal contracting 5 requirements, subject to the Maine Adminisб trative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375. 7 8 Those rules shall provide for approval of contracts by the appropriate state agency.' 9 10 11 Further amend the amendment by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following: 12 13 'Further amend the bill by striking out all of 14 section 35. 15 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end 16 before the statement of fact the following: 17 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-18 19 proved. 20 STATEMENT OF FACT 21 This amendment clarifies that a contractual obligation entered into by the Commissioner of Defense 22 and Veterans' Services are subject to approval of the 23 Bureau of Public Improvements, like contracts for 24 25 other state agencies. The amendment also adds an 26 emergency preamble and an emergency clause. The original bill was intended to take effect last summer 27

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1 at the same time as the recodification of the state 2 military laws. Enactment as an emergency measure 3 will avoid further delay in the implementation of its 4 provisions.

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
