22 23	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
24 25 26	Sec. 1. 37-B MRSA §108, as enacted by PL 1983, c. 460, § 3, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
27	§108. Designation of Deputy Adjutant General
28 29 30 31 32	The assistant adjutant general for the Maine Army National Guard or the assistant adjutant general for the Maine Air National Guard may be appointed as Deputy Adjutant General. The Deputy Adjutant General shall have the powers, responsibilities and duties of

the Adjutant General in the event of the Adjutant General's absence or inability to act, or in case of a vacancy in the office of the Adjutant General until the vacancy is filled by the Governor, as provided by law.

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall take effect 91 days following adjournment of the Legislature.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This new draft amends the recently enacted military recodification bill, L.D. 1593, to allow the Adjutant General to select either the assistant adjutant general of the Maine Army National Guard or the assistant adjutant general of the Maine Air National Guard to be the Deputy Adjutant General. Under current law and the recodification, only the assistant adjutant general of the Maine Army National Guard may be selected as the Deputy Adjutant General. This new draft will become effective 91 days following adjournment of the Legislature and will supersede the existing provision in the recodification bill.
