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AN ACT Relating to the School Year for  
School Administrative District Number 57.

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**Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next school year; and

Whereas, School Administrative District Number 57 has already developed a comprehensive schedule for the 1983-84 school year; and

Whereas, this Act must take effect as soon as possible to enable School Administrative District Number 57 to implement its school year calendar; and
