HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1395, L.D. 1818,
Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify That Notaries Public who do
not Maintain a Seal of Office may Take Acknowledgements."

11 Amend the bill in the first paragraph after the 12 amending clause by striking out all of the last sen-13 tence (page 2, lines 13 to 24 in L.D.) and inserting 14 in its place the following:

15 'The seal of such court or the official seal of such 16 notary public or commissioner, if he has one, shall be affixed to the certificate of acknowledgment, but 17 18 if such acknowledgment is taken outside the State be-19 fore a justice of the peace, notary public not having 20 a seal or commissioner, a certificate under seal from 21 the secretary of state, or elerk of a court of record 22 in the county where the officer resides or took the 23 acknowledgment, authenticating the authority of the officer taking such acknowledgment and the genuine-24 25 ness of his signature, must be annexed thereto.'
