HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1411, L.D. 1833, Bill, "AN ACT to Require the State of Maine to Pay Late Fees on Overdue Payments."

Amend the amendment by inserting after the first paragraph after the title the following:

'Further amend the bill in that part designated "§1553.", subsection 1, in the 4th line (page 3, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure "30" and inserting in its place the following: '25 working'

Further amend the amendment in the 3rd paragraph in the 11th line (page 1, line 24 in the amendment) by striking out the underlined figure "12" and inserting in its place the underlined figure '10'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after the 3rd paragraph after the title the following:

'Amend the bill in that part designated "§1554." in the first paragraph in the 2nd line (page 4, line 2 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure "30" and inserting in its place the following: '25 working'

Further amend the amendment by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Amend the bill in that part designated "§1555.", in the first paragraph in the 5th line (page 4, line 16 of L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "period" the following: ' ,after the required payment date, '

This amendment changes the 30-day period for the state payment of invoices to 25 working days. It also reduces the number of days for the invoice to be processed by the controller and thereby allows line agencies 15 working days during which the State may pay its bills without imposing a late fee upon itself.
