18 Finance a General Assistance Program  
19 for Migrant Workers.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §4301, sub-§8-A is enacted to  
24 read:

25 8-A. Migrant agricultural worker. "Migrant ag-  
26 ricultural worker" means an individual who is em-  
27 ployed in agricultural employment of a seasonal or  
28 other temporary nature, and who is required to be ab-  
29 sent overnight from his permanent place of residence.  
30 The term "migrant agricultural worker" does not in-  
31 clude any immediate family member of an agricultural  
32 employer or any person who, for any money or other  
33 valuable consideration paid or promised to be paid,  
34 performs any farm labor contracting activity.
