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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S.P. 668,
L.D. 1837, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish a Training
Program to Improve Water Quality."

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Amend the Bill in section 1 in that part design-
ated "§4173-A." in subsection 1 by striking out all
of the last underlined sentence.

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Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part
designated "§4173-A." by adding at the end the fol-
lowing:

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'3. Self supporting. Aside from the start-up
cost provided in the bill, this program shall be
self-supporting from fees. The Commissioner of Envi-
ronmental Protection shall report to the First Regu-
lar Session of the 112th Legislature no later than
February 1, 1985, on the necessary fee schedule.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this amendment is to clarify who
the program can be administered by and to establish
the program as being self-supportive by fees in fu-
ture years.
