20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §4173-A is enacted to read:

23 §4173-A. Continuing education

24 1. Training. The Department of Environmental
25 Protection shall administer a continuing educational
26 program for people engaged in water pollution control
27 activities. This program shall provide advanced
28 training in the technical and legal aspects of water
29 pollution control, and coordinate and distribute in-
30 formation about all water pollution control training
31 programs available in the State. The program shall
32 be administered by and implemented through Southern
33 Maine Vocational-Technical Institute.
