AN ACT to Allow Municipalities to Use
Outgoing Voter Check Lists.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

21 MRSA §861, sub-§5, ¶A is enacted to read:

A. If the municipality has required, by ordinance, the use of an outgoing check list, the voter shall announce his name and, upon request, street address to the election clerk in charge of that list prior to depositing the ballots in the ballot box.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this bill is to allow the use of
