The provisions of section 2060, sub-<br>section 5, relating to the terms of office and elec-<br>tion of assessors shall apply to the terms of office<br>and election of assessors of organized plantations.<br>When money is raised for repair of ways and bridges,<br>the assessors of such plantation shall choose one or<br>more road commissioners as selectmen of towns do. |

| 2  | The purpose of this bill is to remove the current     |
| 3  | statutory requirement that plantations must hold      |
| 4  | their annual meeting in March. This requirement pre-  |
| 5  | vents plantations from changing their fiscal years so |
| 6  | that the plantation budget may be considered at the   |
| 7  | same time as the school budget. The present law also  |
| 8  | prevents plantations from changing their fiscal years |
| 9  | to make them compatible with the state's fiscal year. |
| 10 | This bill allows each plantation to establish its     |
| 11 | own annual meeting date by removing the requirement   |
| 12 | that these meetings be held in March.                 |
