

## L.D. 1856 1 2 (Filing No. S- 284) STATE OF MAINE 3 4 SENATE 5 111TH LEGISLATURE 6 SECOND REGULAR SESSION COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " 7 to S.P. 672, 8 L.D. 1856, Bill, "AN ACT to Grandfather Certain Ex-9 isting Part-time Law Enforcement Officers from the 10 Requirement to be Trained by the Maine Criminal Justice Academy." 11 12 Amend the bill by striking out all of the title 13 and inserting in its place the following: 14 'AN ACT to Extend the Date by which Part-time and 15 Reserve Law Enforcement Officers are Required to be 16 Trained and Certified by the Maine Criminal Justice 17 Academy. 18 Further amend the bill by striking out all of 19 section 1 and inserting in its place the following: 20 'Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2805-A, sub-§6 is enacted to 21 read: 22 6. Transition. The provisions of this section 23 that apply to the required training and certification 24 of part-time and reserve law enforcement officers shall become effective on January 1, 1986. This sub-25 section shall not be construed to mean that the date 26 27 for training and certification is extended for persons newly employed by a municipality or county as 28 29 law enforcement officers. Any person newly employed 30 by a municipality or county as a part-time or reserve 31 law enforcement officer on or after September 23, 32 1983, shall be required, within the first year of em-33 ployment, to obtain the required training or certifi-34 cation by the Maine Criminal Justice Academy, as provided in this section. 35

1	STATEMENT OF FACT
2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11	This amendment extends the deadline until January 1, 1986 by which the part-time and reserve law en- forcement officers are required to be trained and certified. The training and certification require- ments for any person newly employed by a municipality or county as a part-time or reserve law enforcement officer, however, is not extended. Part-time law en- forcement officers newly employed by a municipality or county are required to receive training and certi- fication within their first year of employment.
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
