AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Jackman
Sewer District to Provide Adequate
Compensation for Trustees.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Jackman Sewer District is currently engaged in a major water pollution control project having a total estimated cost in excess of \$6,700,000; and

Whereas, the trustees of the Jackman Sewer District, as managers of the district, have been and will continue to be required to meet frequently and to otherwise expend increased amounts of time and effort to carry out their responsibilities to the district during the planning, design and construction phases of the water pollution control project; and
