HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1422, L.D. 1867,
Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Open Burning of Leaves
and Brush."

Amend the bill in paragraph F in the 4th line
(page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by inserting after the word
"permissible" the following: 'unless expressly pro-
hibited by the municipality in all or part of the mu-
nicipality through an ordinance'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that
a municipality may prohibit open burning of leaves
and brush through enactment of an ordinance.
