25 26 27 28 29	A juror shall be paid mileage at the rate of 15¢ 22¢ per mile for his travel expenses from his residence to the place of holding court and return and shall be compensated at the rate of \$20 for each day of required attendance at sessions of the court.

1	STATEMENT OF FACT
2 3 4	The purpose of this bill is to increase the mileage payment to jurors from 15¢ a mile to 22¢ a mile, which is the rate currently paid to witnesses.
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
