priate to carry out the purposes of this Act, and order other energy conservation techniques, programs and innovations relating to electric public utility service that, in the commission's judgment, are practicable, just and reasonably related to fulfilling the purposes of this chapter. In ordering any rate design improvements, or a program calling for electric utility financing or subsidization of capital improvements undertaken by ratepayers to conserve the ratepayer's future use of electricity, the commission shall consider and assure the revenue requirements of the utility. In ordering any program of electric utility financing or subsidization of capital improvements to conserve the ratepayer's future use electricity, the commission shall at the same time provide for the prompt recovery from ratepayers of the reasonable start-up costs of the program. commission may permit a utility to capitalize of capital improvements undertaken value by electric ratepayers which were accomplished through utility financing or subsidization to the extent of the investment by the utility.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill permits the Public Utilities Commission to give rate base treatment to those capital improvements made by ratepayers through the use of financing or subsidies provided by an electric utility. recognizes that capital improvements made by a bill ratepayer can achieve a similar result to the construction of new electricity sources. For example, insulation which reduces demand has the same effect building a new plant to meet increasing demand. This bill authorizes the commission to give recognition to the interrelationship of supply increases and demand reductions. The bill, also, requires the Public Utilities Commission to assure that utilities recover the costs of such programs and that there is a prompt recovery by the utility of the reasonable start-up costs of the program.
