not preclude the department from placing a moderately or severely retarded child in any other appropriate child care facility at the department's discretion.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purposes of this bill are (1) to provide that more than 4 children can be placed in a specialized foster home in order to keep siblings together rather than separating them, and (2) to clarify that specialized children's homes are not the only kind of facility into which moderately or severely handicapped children can be placed. For example, a moderately or severely handicapped child could also be appropriately cared for in a foster family home or a residential child care facility.
