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**RESOLVE, Adopting a Permanent Plan for  
Federal Surplus Property.**

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**Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the United States Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949, Section 203(j) (4) (A), as amended, requires that each state develop a detailed plan of operation before any federal surplus property may be transferred to any state agency; and

Whereas, the United States General Services Administration has established June 30, 1984, as the deadline for submission of a permanent plan of operation, and failure to adopt a plan could result in hardship to state agencies and nonprofit organizations seeking federal surplus property; and
