20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 20-A MRSA §6 is enacted to read:

23 §5. Military recruiters; duty to provide access

24 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the
25 contrary, all public high schools and all institu-
26 tions within the state university system, and all
27 private high schools, colleges and universities which
28 receive state funds, shall offer the same on-campus
29 recruiting opportunities to representatives of state
30 or United States Armed Forces as they offer to
31 nonmilitary recruiters.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill requires all public high schools, state colleges and universities and all private schools, colleges and universities to provide the same access to their students to military recruiters as they provide to nonmilitary recruiters.

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
