17 18 19	AN ACT to Amend the Air Emission License Law.
20 21	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
22 23 24	<b>38 MRSA §582, sub-§5,</b> as enacted by PL 1969, c. 474, §1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

"Ambient air" means air outside of buildings, stacks, flues or exterior ducts and outside a zone adjacent to an air contamination source which is under the exclusive jurisdiction and control of an applicant for a variance or license pursuant to this chapter and is regularly occupied by employees of the applicant and from which the public is excluded, provided that the zone shall not exceed an area with a radius a distance of 500 meters from a stack, conduit, flue, duct, vent, chimney or other apparatus which emits air contaminents.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

The current air emission license law does not provide for an area immediately outside a stack or flue which is not required to meet ambient air quality standards. In practice the Board of Environmental Protection has allowed each applicant a "mixing zone" around the stack or flue, but the statute does not expressly allow for such a zone.

9 The purpose of this bill is to establish this 10 zone as the plant area from which the public is ex-11 cluded, but not to exceed an area more than 500 me-12 ters from the source emitting the air contaminents. 13 This definition will continue to protect the general 14 public. Employees will continue to be protected by 15 state and federal labor laws and industrial codes.
