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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1469,
L.D. 1921, Bill, "AN ACT to Prevent Unfair Charges
for Submitting Applications for Work."

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Amend the bill in that part designated "§594." in
the first sentence 4th line (page 2, line 12 of L.D.)
by inserting after the underlined word "employment"
the following: 'with that employer'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this amendment is to make it clear
that it is unlawful for employers to charge job ap-
plicants a fee for applying for employment with that
employer. The bill does not prohibit employment
agencies from charging their customers a fee for uti-
lizing the agency's job search services.
