**AN ACT to Authorize a Study of the
Subject of a Lobster Trap Limit Off the Coast
of Maine.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. Study authorized. The Joint Standing Committee on Marine Resources, in cooperation with the Department of Marine Resources, the Lobster Advisory Council, the Maine Lobstermen's Association and such other agencies or organizations as it may deem appropriate, shall investigate and study the subject matter of establishing a lobster trap limit within the coastal waters of the State.

Sec. 2. Hearings. In conducting this study the Joint Standing Committee on Marine Resources shall hold public hearings in the major port cities throughout the State to receive testimony on this subject.
