HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1487, L.D. 1950,
Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for Reapportionment of County
Commissioner Districts."

Amend the Bill in section 2, in subsection 8,
paragraph A in the 3rd line (page 7, line 38 in L.D.)
by striking out the underlined words "Wiscasset and
Westport" and inserting in their place the following:
'Westport and Wiscasset'

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end
before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 3. 30 MRSA §105-X is enacted to read:

§105-X. Residency and election of county commissioners

Members of each board of commissioners created
under section 105-W shall be residents of the commis-
sioner district which they represent and shall be
elected by the qualified voters of that district, ex-
cept that members of the Piscataquis County Board of
Commissioners shall be residents of the commissioner
district which they represent and shall be elected at
large by the qualified voters of the county.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this amendment is to reinstate the
3 provision dealing with the residency of county com-
4 missioners which was inadvertently omitted from the
5 original bill. This amendment also corrects the al-
6 phabetical listing of 2 municipalities in Lincoln
7 County.
