HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1487, L.D. 1950,

Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for Reapportionment of Coun-

9

ty Commissioner Districts."

Amend the Bill in section 2, subsection 1, by
11 striking out all of paragraph A (page 1, lines 29 to
12 32 and page 2, lines 1 to 28 in L.D.) and inserting
13 in its place the following:

14

'A. Commissioner District Number 1, in the Coun-
15 ty of Androscoggin, consists of the municipali-
16 ties of Green, Leeds, Lisbon, Livermore,
17 Livermore Falls, Sabattus, Turner, Wales and that
18 portion of the City of Lewiston described as fol-
19 lows: Beginning on College Road at the Greene
20 town line; thence in a general southeasterly di-
21 rection along the Greene town line to Old Greene
22 Road; thence in a general southwesterly direction
23 along Old Green Road to North Temple Street;
24 thence in a general southwesterly direction along
25 North Temple Street to Sabattus Street; thence in
26 a general westerly direction along Sabattus
27 Street to Nichols Street; thence in a general
28 northeasterly direction along Nichols Street to
29 Holland Street; thence in a general northwesterly
30 direction along Holland Street to College Street;
31 thence in a general northeasterly direction along
32 College Street to the point of beginning. Not-
33 withstanding the provisions of section 105-V,
34 subsection 3, the term of office of the county
35 commissioner from this district shall expire in
36 1984, in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.'

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Further amend the Bill in section 2, subsection

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1, by striking out all of paragraph C (page 2, lines

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37 to 45 and page 3, lines 1 to 21 in L.D.) and in-

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1 serting in its place the following:

2 'C. Commissioner District Number 3, in the Coun-
3 ty of Androscoggin, consists of all of the City
4 of Lewiston, excepting that portion as described
5 in County Commissioner District Number 1. Not-
6 withstanding the provisions of section 105-V,
7 subsection 3, the term of office of the county
8 commissioner from this district shall expire in
9 1984 and every 4 years thereafter.'

10 Further amend the Bill in section 2, in subsec-
11 tion 8, paragraph A in the 3rd line (page 7, line 38
12 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words
13 "Wiscasset and Westport" and inserting in their place
14 the following: 'Westport and Wiscasset'

15 Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end
16 before the statement of fact the following:

17 'Sec. 3. 30 MRSA §105-X is enacted to read:

18 §105-X. Residency and election of county commission-
19 ers

20 Members of each board of commissioners created
21 under section 105-W shall be residents of the commis-
22 sioner district which they represent and shall be
23 elected by the qualified voters of that district, ex-
24 cept that members of the Piscataquis County Board of
25 Commissioners shall be residents of the commissioner
26 district which they represent and shall be elected at
27 large by the qualified voters of the county.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this amendment is to reinstate the provision dealing with the residency of county commissioners which was inadvertently omitted from the original bill. This amendment also corrects the alphabetical listing of 2 municipalities in Lincoln County. This amendment also corrects the discription of Androscoggin County.
