SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1487, L.D. 1950,
Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for Reapportionment of County
Commissioner Districts."

Amend the Bill by inserting after the Title and
before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
lature do not become effective until 90 days after
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, terms of office of certain county com-
missioners may expire before 90 days after the ad-
journment of the Legislature; and

Whereas, unless this legislation is enacted as
emergency legislation, it may be necessary to hold
special elections to clarify the terms of office of
these commissioners; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
the Constitution of Maine and require the following
legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
therefore,

Further amend the Bill by inserting before the
Statement of Fact the following:


'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency
cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect
when approved.'
