17 AN ACT to Provide for Reapportionment of
18 County Commissioner Districts.
19

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 30 MRSA §§105-A to 105-U, as amended,
23 are repealed.

24 Sec. 2. 30 MRSA §105-W is enacted to read:

25 §105-W. County commissioner districts

26 1. Creation of Androscoggin County Commissioner
27 Districts. Androscoggin County shall be divided into
28 the following 3 districts.

29 A. Commissioner District Number 1, in the County
30 of Androscoggin, consists of the municipalities
31 of Greene, Leeds, Lisbon, Livermore, Livermore
32 Falls, Sabattus, Turner, Wales and that portion

1 of the City of Lewiston south of a line described
2 as follows: Beginning at the Androscoggin River
3 at the inlet which approaches Lincoln Street;
4 thence north along the inlet of the Androscoggin
5 River, across Lincoln Street, to a point ap-
6 proaching Lisbon Street, east of Locust Street,
7 the line to correspond to the boundary between
8 House Districts 67 and 69 and to the division
9 lines between Tracts 204 and 205, City of
10 Lewiston, 1980 Federal Census of Maine; thence
11 along a line to Lisbon Street; thence south on
12 Lisbon Street to Arcadia Street; thence northeast
13 on Arcadia Street to Pleasant Street; thence
14 northwest on Pleasant Street to Bartlett Street;
15 thence north on Bartlett Street to Walnut Street;
16 thence east on Walnut Street to Webster Street;
17 thence southeast on Webster Street to Mitchell
18 Street; thence southwest on Mitchell Street to
19 Pleasant Street; thence east on Pleasant Street
20 to Lisbon Street; thence southeast on Lisbon
21 Street (Rte. 196) across the Maine Turnpike to
22 the Maine Central Railroad; thence east and south
23 along the Maine Central Railroad tracks to the
24 Lewiston-Lisbon boundary. Notwithstanding the
25 provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the
26 term of office of the county commissioner from
27 this district shall expire in 1984, in 1986 and
28 every 4 years thereafter.

29 B. Commissioner District Number 2, in the County
30 of Androscoggin, consists of the municipalities
31 of Auburn, Durham, Mechanic Falls, Minot and
32 Poland. Notwithstanding the provisions of sec-
33 tion 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of
34 the county commissioner from this district shall
35 expire in 1984, in 1986 and every 4 years there-
36 after.

37 C. Commissioner District Number 3, in the County
38 of Androscoggin, consists of that portion of the
39 City of Lewiston north of a line described as
40 follows: Beginning at the Androscoggin River at
41 an inlet which approaches Lincoln Street; thence
42 north along an inlet of the Androscoggin River,
43 across Lincoln Street, to a point approaching
44 Lisbon Street, east of Locust Street, the line to
45 correspond to the boundary between House Dis-

1 tricts 67 and 69 and to the division lines be-
2 tween Tracts 204 and 205, City of Lewiston, 1980
3 Federal Census of Maine; thence along a line to
4 Lisbon Street; thence south on Lisbon Street to
5 Arcadia Street; thence northeast on Arcadia
6 Street to Pleasant Street; thence northwest on
7 Pleasant Street to Bartlett Street; thence north
8 on Bartlett Street to Walnut Street; thence east
9 on Walnut Street to Webster Street; thence south-
10 east on Webster Street to Mitchell Street; thence
11 southwest on Mitchell Street to Pleasant Street;
12 thence east on Pleasant Street to Lisbon Street;
13 thence southeast on Lisbon Street (Rte. 196)
14 across the Maine Turnpike to the Maine Central
15 Railroad; thence east and south along the Maine
16 Central Railroad tracks to the Lewiston-Lisbon
17 boundary. Notwithstanding the provisions of
18 section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office
19 of the county commissioner from this district
20 shall expire in 1984 and every 4 years thereaf-
21 ter.

22 2. Creation of Aroostook County Commissioner
23 Districts. Aroostook County shall be divided into
24 the following 3 districts.

25 A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of
26 the municipalities of Amity, Ashland, Bancroft,
27 Benedicta, Blaine, Bridgewater, Cary Plantation,
28 Crystal, Dyer Brook, E Plantation, Easton, Fort
29 Fairfield, Garfield Plantation, Glenwood
30 Plantation, Hammond, Haynesville, Hersey,
31 Hodgdon, Houlton, Island Falls, Linneus,
32 Littleton, Ludlow, Macwahoc Plantation, Mars
33 Hill, Masardis, Merrill, Monticello, Moro
34 Plantation, Nashville Plantation, New Limerick,
35 Oakfield, Orient, Oxbow Plantation, Reed
36 Plantation, Sherman, Smyrna, Westfield, Weston,
37 and the unorganized territories of central
38 Aroostook and south Aroostook. Notwithstanding
39 the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3,
40 the term of office of the county commissioner
41 from this district shall expire in 1984 and every
42 4 years thereafter.

43 B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of
44 the municipalities of Allagash, Caribou, Castle

1 Hill, Chapman, Eagle Lake, Mapleton, Perham, Por-
2 tage Lake, Presque Isle, St. Francis, St. John
3 Plantation, Wade, Washburn, Westmanland,
4 Winterville Plantation and the unorganized terri-
5 tories of northwest Aroostook and Square Lake.
6 Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V,
7 subsection 3, the term of office of the commis-
8 sioner from this district shall expire in 1984,
9 in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.

10 C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of
11 the municipalities of Caswell Plantation, Cyr
12 Plantation, Fort Kent, Frenchville, Grand Isle,
13 Hamlin, Limestone, Madawaska, New Canada, New
14 Sweden, Saint Agatha, Stockholm, Van Buren,
15 Wallagrass Plantation, Woodland and the unorga-
16 nized territory of Conner. Notwithstanding the
17 provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the
18 term of office of the commissioner from this dis-
19 trict shall expire in 1984, in 1986 and every 4
20 years thereafter.

21 3. Creation of Cumberland County Commissioner
22 Districts. Cumberland County shall be divided into
23 the following 3 districts.

24 A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of
25 the municipalities of Falmouth and Portland.
26 Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V,
27 subsection 3, the term of office of the commis-
28 sioner from this district shall expire in 1984,
29 in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.

30 B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of
31 the municipalities of Baldwin, Cape Elizabeth,
32 Gorham, Scarborough, South Portland, Standish and
33 Westbrook. Notwithstanding the provisions of
34 section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office
35 of the commissioner from this district shall ex-
36 pire in 1984, in 1986 and every 4 years thereaf-
37 ter.

38 C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of
39 the municipalities of Bridgton, Brunswick, Casco,
40 Cumberland, Freeport, Gray, Harpswell, Harrison,
41 Naples, New Gloucester, North Yarmouth, Pownal,
42 Raymond, Sebago, Windham and Yarmouth. Notwith-

1 standing the provisions of section 105-V, sub-
2 section 3, the term of office of the commissioner
3 from this district shall expire in 1984 and every
4 4 years thereafter.

5 4. Creation of Franklin County Commissioner Dis-
6 tricts. Franklin County shall be divided into the
7 following 3 districts.

8 A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of
9 the municipalities of Jay and Wilton. Notwith-
10 standing the provisions of section 105-V, sub-
11 section 3, the term of office of the commissioner
12 from this district shall expire in 1984 and every
13 4 years thereafter.

14 B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of
15 the municipalities of Chesterville, Farmington,
16 Industry and New Sharon. Notwithstanding the
17 provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the
18 term of office of the commissioner from this dis-
19 trict shall expire in 1984 and every 4 years
20 thereafter.

21 C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of
22 the municipalities of Avon, Carrabassett Valley,
23 Carthage, Coplin Plantation, Dallas Plantation,
24 Eustis, Kingfield, Madrid, New Vineyard,
25 Phillips, Rangely Plantation, Rangely, Sandy Riv-
26 er Plantation, Strong, Temple, Weld and the unor-
27 ganized territories of East Franklin, North
28 Franklin, South Franklin, West Central Franklin
29 and Wyman. Notwithstanding the provisions of
30 section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office
31 of the commissioner from this district shall ex-
32 pire in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.

33 5. Creation of Hancock County Commissioner Dis-
34 tricts. Hancock County shall be divided into the
35 following 3 districts.

36 A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of
37 the municipalities of Amherst, Aurora, Blue Hill,
38 Dedham, Eastbrook, Ellsworth, Gouldsboro, Great
39 Pond, Mariaville, Osborn, Otis, Sorrento,
40 Sullivan, Surry, Waltham, Winter Harbor and the
41 unorganized territories of Central Hancock,

1 East Hancock and North Hancock. Notwithstanding
2 the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3,
3 the term of office of the commissioner from this
4 district shall expire in 1984, in 1986 and every
5 4 years thereafter.

6 B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of
7 the municipalities of Brooklin, Brooksville,
8 Bucksport, Castine, Deer Isle, Orland, Penobscot,
9 Sedgwick, Stonington and Verona. Notwithstanding
10 the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3,
11 the term of office of the commissioner from this
12 district shall expire in 1984 and every 4 years
13 thereafter.

14 C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of
15 the municipalities of Bar Harbor, Cranberry
16 Isles, Franklin, Frenchboro, Hancock, Lamoine,
17 Mount Desert, Southwest Harbor, Swan's Island,
18 Tremont and Trenton. Notwithstanding the provi-
19 sions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term
20 of office of the commissioner from this district
21 shall expire in 1984, in 1986 and every 4 years
22 thereafter.

23 6. Creation of Kennebec County Commissioner Dis-
24 tricts. Kennebec County shall be divided into the
25 following 3 districts.

26 A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of
27 the municipalities of Augusta, Chelsea, China,
28 Randolph, Sidney, Vassalboro and Windsor. Not-
29 withstanding the provisions of section 105-V,
30 subsection 3, the term of office of the commis-
31 sioner from this district shall expire in 1984,
32 in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.

33 B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of
34 the municipalities of Belgrade, Farmingdale, Fay-
35 ette, Gardiner, Hallowell, Litchfield,
36 Manchester, Monmouth, Mount Vernon, Pittston,
37 Readfield, Rome, Vienna, Wayne, West Gardiner and
38 Winthrop. Notwithstanding the provisions of
39 section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office
40 of the commissioner from this district shall ex-
41 pire in 1984 and every 4 years thereafter.

1 C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of
2 the municipalities of Albion, Benton, Clinton,
3 Oakland, Waterville, Winslow, and Unity Township.
4 Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V,
5 subsection 3, the term of office of the commis-
6 sioner from this district shall expire in 1984,
7 in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.

8 7. Creation of Knox County Commissioner Dis-
9 tricts. Knox County shall be divided into the fol-
10 lowing 3 districts.

11 A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of
12 the municipalities of Owls Head, Rockland and
13 South Thomaston. Notwithstanding the provisions
14 of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of of-
15 office of the commissioner from this district shall
16 expire in 1984 and every 4 years thereafter.

17 B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of
18 the municipalites of Cushing, Friendship, Isle au
19 Haut, Matinicus Isle Plantation, North Haven, St.
20 George, Thomaston, Vinalhaven, Warren and the un-
21 organized territory of Criehaven. Notwithstand-
22 ing the provisions of section 105-V, subsection
23 3, the term of office of the commissioner from
24 this district shall expire in 1984, in 1986 and
25 every 4 years thereafter.

26 C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of
27 the municipalities of Appleton, Camden, Hope,
28 Rockport, Union and Washington. Notwithstanding
29 the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3,
30 the term of office of the commissioner from this
31 district shall expire in 1984 and every 4 years
32 thereafter.

33 8. Creation of Lincoln County Commissioner Dis-
34 tricts. Lincoln County shall be divided into the
35 following 3 districts.

36 A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of
37 the municipalities of Boothbay, Boothbay Harbor,
38 Southport, Wiscasset and Westport. Notwithstand-
39 ing the provisions of section 105-V, subsection
40 3, the term of office of the commissioner from
41 this district shall expire in 1984 and every 4
42 years thereafter.

1 B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of
2 the municipalities of Bremen, Bristol, Monhegan
3 Plantation, Nobleboro, South Bristol and
4 Waldoboro. Notwithstanding the provisions of
5 section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office
6 of the commissioner from this district shall ex-
7 pire in 1984, in 1986 and every 4 years thereaf-
8 ter. The existing vacancy shall be filled ac-
9 ording to the provisions of section 105-V, sub-
10 section 3.

11 C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of
12 the municipalities of Alna, Damariscotta,
13 Dresden, Edgecomb, Jefferson, Newcastle,
14 Somerville, Whitefield and the unorganized terri-
15 tory of Hibberts Gore. Notwithstanding the pro-
16 visions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term
17 of office of the commissioner from this district
18 shall expire in 1984 and every 4 years thereaf-
19 ter.

20 9. Creation of Oxford County Commissioner Dis-
21 tricts. Oxford County shall be divided into the fol-
22 lowing 3 districts.

23 A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of
24 the municipalities of Andover, Bethel,
25 Brownfield, Denmark, Fryeburg, Gilead, Hanover,
26 Hiram, Lovell, Newry, Norway, Porter, Stoneham,
27 Stow, Sweden, Waterford and the unorganized ter-
28 ritories of North Oxford and those portions of
29 South Oxford known as Batchelders Grant and Ma-
30 son. Notwithstanding the provisions of section
31 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of the
32 commissioner from this district shall expire in
33 1984, in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.

34 B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of
35 the municipalities of Byron, Dixfield, Lincoln
36 Plantation, Magalloway Plantation, Mexico, Peru,
37 Roxbury, Rumford and Upton. Notwithstanding the
38 provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the
39 term of office of the commissioner from this dis-
40 trict shall expire in 1984, in 1986 and every 4
41 years thereafter.

1 C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of
2 the municipalities of Buckfield, Canton,
3 Greenwood, Hartford, Hebron, Otisfield, Oxford,
4 Paris, Sumner, West Paris, Woodstock and the un-
5 organized territories of Milton and that portion
6 of South Oxford known as Albany. Notwithstanding
7 the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3,
8 the term of office of the commissioner from this
9 district shall expire in 1984 and every 4 years
10 thereafter.

11 10. Creation of Penobscot County Commissioner
12 Districts. Penobscot County shall be divided into
13 the following 3 districts.

14 A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of
15 the municipalities of Bangor, Brewer and Hampden.
16 Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V,
17 subsection 3, the term of office of the commis-
18 sioner from this district shall expire in 1984,
19 in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.

20 B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of
21 the municipalities of Carmel, Clifton, Corinna,
22 Corinth, Dexter, Dixmont, Eddington, Etna,
23 Exeter, Garland, Glenburn, Hermon, Holden,
24 Kenduskeag, Levant, Newburgh, Newport, Orono,
25 Orrington, Plymouth, Stetson and Veazie. Not-
26 withstanding the provisions of section 105-V,
27 subsection 3, the term of office of the commis-
28 sioner from this district shall expire in 1984,
29 in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.

30 C. Commissioner District Number 3, consists of
31 the municipalities of Alton, Bradford, Bradley,
32 Burlington, Carroll Plantation, Charleston, Ches-
33 ter, Drew Plantation, East Millinocket, Edinburg,
34 Enfield, Greenbush, Greenfield, Howland, Hudson,
35 Lagrange, Lakeville, Lee, Lincoln, Lowell,
36 Mattawamkeag, Maxfield, Medway, Milford,
37 Millinocket, Mount Chase, Old Town, Passadumkeag,
38 Patten, Prentiss Plantation, Seboeis Plantation,
39 Springfield, Stacyville, Webster Plantation,
40 Winn, Woodville, Penobscot Indian Island Reserva-
41 tion; and the unorganized territories of Argyle,
42 Grand Falls, Kingman, North Penobscot, Summit,
43 Twombly and Whitney. Notwithstanding the provi-

1 sions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of
2 office of the commissioner from this district
3 shall expire in 1986 and every 4 years thereaf-
4 ter.

5 11. Creation of Piscataquis County Commissioner
6 Districts. Piscataquis County shall be divided into
7 the following 3 districts.

8 A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of
9 the municipalities of Abbot, Beaver Cove,
10 Blanchard Plantation, Greenville, Guilford,
11 Kingsbury Plantation, Monson, Shirley,
12 Wellington, Willimantic and the unorganized ter-
13 ritory of Elliottsville. Notwithstanding the
14 provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the
15 term of office of the commissioner from this dis-
16 trict shall expire in 1984 and every 4 years
17 thereafter.

18 B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of
19 the municipalities of Dover-Foxcroft, Parkman and
20 Sangerville. Notwithstanding the provisions of
21 section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office
22 of the commissioner from this district shall ex-
23 pire in 1984 and every 4 years thereafter.

24 C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of
25 the municipalities of Atkinson, Bowerbank,
26 Brownville, Lake View Plantation, Medford, Milo,
27 Sebec and the unorganized territories of Barnard,
28 Northeast Piscataquis, Northwest Piscataquis and
29 Southeast Piscataquis. Notwithstanding the pro-
30 visions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term
31 of office of the commissioner from this district
32 shall expire in 1984, in 1986 and every 4 years
33 thereafter.

34 12. Creation of Sagadahoc County Commissioner
35 Districts. Sagadahoc County shall be divided into
36 the following 3 districts.

37 A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of
38 the municipalities of Bowdoin, Bowdoinham and
39 Topsham. Notwithstanding the provisions of sec-
40 tion 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of
41 the commissioner from this district shall expire
42 in 1984, in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.

1 B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of
2 the municipalities of Arrowsic, Georgetown,
3 Phippsburg, Richmond, West Bath, Woolwich, the
4 unorganized territory of Perkins, and that por-
5 tion of the City of Bath south and east of a line
6 described as follows: Beginning at the Carleton
7 Bridge a line west to King Street at Water
8 Street, thence west on King Street to Washington
9 Street, thence south on Washington Street to Bath
10 Street, thence west on Bath Street to High
11 Street, thence south on High Street to Pine
12 Street, thence east on Pine Street to Washington
13 Street, thence south on Washington Street to an
14 inlet of the Kennebec River (which is just north
15 of Hunt Street). Notwithstanding the provisions
16 of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of of-
17 fice of the commissioner from this district shall
18 expire in 1984, in 1986 and every 4 years there-
19 after.

20 C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of
21 that portion of the City of Bath north and west
22 of a line described as follows: Beginning at the
23 Carleton Bridge a line west to King Street at Wa-
24 ter Street, thence west on King Street to Wash-
25 ington Street, thence south on Washington Street
26 to Bath Street, thence west on Bath Street to
27 High Street, thence south on High Street to Pine
28 Street, thence east on Pine Street to Washington
29 Street and thence south on Washington Street to
30 an inlet of the Kennebec River (which is just
31 north of Hunt Street). Notwithstanding the pro-
32 visions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term
33 of office of the commissioner from this district
34 shall expire in 1984 and every 4 years thereaf-
35 ter.

36 13. Creation of Somerset County Commissioner
37 Districts. Somerset County shall be divided into the
38 following 3 districts.

39 A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of
40 the municipalities of Anson, Athens, Bingham,
41 Brighton Plantation, Cambridge, Caratunk,
42 Dennistown Plantation, Embden, Harmony, Hartland,
43 Highland Plantation, Jackman, Moose River,
44 Moscow, New Portland, Palmyra, Pleasant Ridge

1 Plantation, Ripley, St. Albans, Starks, The Forks
2 Plantation, West Forks Plantation and the unorga-
3 nized territories of Central Somerset, Northeast
4 Somerset, Northwest Somerset and Seboomook Lake.
5 Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V,
6 subsection 3, the term of office of the commis-
7 sioner from this district shall expire in 1984,
8 in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.

9 B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of
10 the municipalities of Fairfield, Madison, Mercer,
11 Norridgewock, Smithfield and Solon. Notwith-
12 standing the provisions of section 105-V, sub-
13 section 3, the term of office of the commissioner
14 from this district shall expire in 1984 and every
15 4 years thereafter.

16 C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of
17 the municipalities of Canaan, Cornville, Detroit,
18 Pittsfield and Skowhegan. Notwithstanding the
19 provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3, the
20 term of office of the commissioner from this dis-
21 trict shall expire in 1984, in 1986 and every 4
22 years thereafter.

23 14. Creation of Waldo County Commissioner Dis-
24 tricts. Waldo County shall be divided into the fol-
25 lowing 3 districts.

26 A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of
27 the municipalities of Belfast, Belmont,
28 Islesboro, Lincolnville and Northport. Notwith-
29 standing the provisions of section 105-V, sub-
30 section 3, the term of office of the commissioner
31 from this district shall expire in 1984 and every
32 4 years thereafter.

33 B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of
34 the municipalities of Frankfort, Jackson, Monroe,
35 Prospect, Searsport, Stockton Springs, Swanville
36 and Winterport. Notwithstanding the provisions
37 of section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of of-
38 fice of the commissioner from this district shall
39 expire in 1984, in 1986 and every 4 years there-
40 after.

1 C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of
2 the municipalities of Brooks, Burnham, Freedom,
3 Knox, Liberty, Montville, Morrill, Palermo,
4 Searsmont, Thorndike, Troy, Unity and Waldo.
5 Notwithstanding the provisions of section 105-V,
6 subsection 3, the term of office of the commis-
7 sioner from this district shall expire in 1984,
8 in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.

9 15. Creation of York County Commissioner Dis-
10 tricts. York County shall be divided into the fol-
11 lowing 3 districts.

12 A. Commissioner District Number 1 consists of
13 the municipalities of Acton, Berwick, Buxton,
14 Cornish, Eliot, Hollis, Kittery, Lebanon,

16 Parsonsfield and South Berwick. Notwithstanding
17 the provisions of section 105-V, subsection 3,
18 the term of office of the commissioner from this
19 district shall expire in 1984, in 1986 and every
20 4 years thereafter.

21 B. Commissioner District Number 2 consists of
22 the municipalities of Arundel, Biddeford,
23 Kennebunk, Kennebunkport, Ogunquit, Wells and
24 York. Notwithstanding the provisions of sec-
25 tion 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office of
26 the commissioner from this district shall expire
27 in 1986 and every 4 years thereafter.

28 C. Commissioner District Number 3 consists of
29 the municipalities of Alfred, Dayton, Lyman, Old
30 Orchard Beach, Saco, Sanford, Shapleigh and
31 Waterboro. Notwithstanding the provisions of
32 section 105-V, subsection 3, the term of office
33 of the commissioner from this district shall ex-
34 pire in 1984, in 1986 and every 4 years thereaf-
35 ter.
