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HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A"
to S.P. 709, L.D. 1955, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend Cer-
tain Rules of the Emergency Medical Services."

Amend the amendment by inserting at the end be-
fore the statement of fact a new paragraph to read:

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'In addition, notwithstanding current regula-
tions, the following conditions shall apply. Re-
quirements for licensure at the intermediate lev-
el shall allow an applicant to be licensed for
intravenous therapy or defibrillation therapy, or
both. If a licensed ambulance service operating
within this State is sold to a new operator, the
ambulances licensed to that service on the date
of sale shall be licensed and relicensed by the
new operator, as long as they are maintained in a
condition which will meet all Department of Pub-
lic Safety standards for vehicle safety and are
in a clean and sanitary condition, free from in-
terior rust, dirt or contaminating foreign mat-
ter.'
