AN ACT to Authorize Approval by the
Governor of Levels of Compensation
for Independent Agencies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 MRS A §8 is enacted to read:

8. Independent agencies; compensation. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, the Governor may review and approve the level of compensation of all employees of independent agencies.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to authorize approval by the Governor of the level of compensation for employees of independent agencies. At present, the

1 Health Cost Containment, Maine Housing Authority, Fi-
2 nance Authority of Maine and other independent agen-
3 cies set their own level of compensation without any
4 input from the Governor. This bill is not meant to
5 include employees of the University of Maine.

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
