**AN ACT to Include the Chief Executive
Officer of the Finance Authority of Maine
as an Ex Officio Corporator of the Maine
Development Foundation.**

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
lature do not become effective until 90 days after
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, by act of the 111th Legislature, the
Maine Guarantee Authority was abolished and the Fi-
nance Authority of Maine was created in its stead;
and

Whereas, it is the intent of the Legislature that
the heads of major state departments shall serve as
ex officio corporators of the Maine Development Foun-
dation; and

1 Whereas, there is presently a vacancy in the num-
2 ber of ex officio corporators of the Maine Develop-
3 ment Foundation due to the abolishment of the posi-
4 tion of Manager of the Maine Guarantee Authority; and

5 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
6 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
7 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
8 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
9 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
10 therefore,

11 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
12 follows:

13 10 MRSA §918, sub-§3, as amended by PL 1983, c.
14 553, §46, is further amended to read:

15 3. Ex officio corporators. Ex officio corpora-
16 tors shall consist of the heads of the major state
17 departments and agencies and the Chancellor of the
18 University of Maine. State department and agency
19 heads shall include the following:

20 Treasurer of State;

21 Director of the State Planning Office;

22 Director of the State Development Office;

23 Commissioner of Agriculture, Food and Rural Re-
24 sources;

25 Commissioner of Business, Occupational and Pro-
26 fessional Regulation;

27 Commissioner of Conservation;

28 Commissioner of Educational and Cultural Ser-
29 vices;

30 Commissioner of Environmental Protection;

31 Commissioner of Finance and Administration;

32 Commissioner of Human Services;
