9	STATEMENT OF FACT
10	The purpose of this amendment is to make munici-
11	palities solely responsible for the enforcement of
12	municipal shellfish ordinances, to make certain minor
13	technical corrections and to give municipal shellfish
14	wardens the powers to arrest, serve process and con-
15	duct searches where there is probable cause. All
16	powers are limited to the enforcement of a municipal
17	shellfish ordinance.
