7	HOUSE AMENDMENT " β " to H.P. 1501, L.D. 1975,
8	Bill, "AN ACT to Permit Possession of Soft-shell Clam
9	Stocks 2 Inches or Greater in the Largest Diameter."
10	Amend the Bill in section 1 by striking out all
11	of subsections 1 and 2 and inserting in their place
12	the following:
13	'1. Fees to be paid into fund. Twenty-five
14	<u>Ninety</u> percent of all fees from shellfish licenses,
15	shellfish transportation licenses and wholesale
16	seafood license shall be paid into the Shellfish
17	Fund. Ten percent of the fees from these licenses
18	shall be paid into the General Fund. The fee for each
19	of these licenses shall be \$100.
20	2. Uses of fund. The commissioner may expend the
21	money in the Shellfish Fund for Ten percent of the
22	money in the Shellfish Fund may be expended by the
23	commissioner for management, enforcement, restora-
24	tion, development and conservation of shellfish in
25	the intertidal zone or coastal waters. Ten percent of
26	the money shall be paid into the General Fund. Seven-
27	ty-five percent of the money in the Shellfish Fund
28	shall be used for reimbursement to municipalities
29	which have local conservation ordinances. Five per-
30	cent of the money in the Shellfish Fund shall be used
31	by the commissioner for the administration of munici-
32	pal reimbursement under this subsection.'
33	Further amend the Bill in section 3 by striking
34	out all of subsection 3 and inserting in its place
35	the following:

36 '3. Shellfish conservation ordinance. Within any
37 area in of the intertidal zone or coastal waters in

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1 the municipality, a shellfish conservation ordinance 2 may regulate or prohibit the taking possession of 3 shellfish; may fix the amount of shellfish that may be taken; may shall limit the size of seft shell 4 soft-shell clams; may fix the qualifications for a license; including municipal residency; may fix li-5 6 7 eense fees in accordance with subchapter I, article 8 5; and may authorize the municipal officers to open and close flats under specified conditions. No A pro-9 gram or ordinance shall shall not regulate areas closed by regulation of the commissioner. An ordi-10 11 12 nance may also provide for enforcement, protection 13 and evaluation of a green crab fencing program.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purposes of this amendment are to set the fee for shellfish licenses, provide reimbursement to municipalities, provide funds to the commission for enforcement and administration purposes, prevent loss of revenues to the General Fund and to prohibit towns from issuing municipal shellfish licenses.
