17 18 19 20	AN ACT Concerning the Disclosure of Licensing Records Regarding Adult and Child Care Programs.
21 22	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
23	22 MRSA §7703 is enacted to read:
. 24	§7703. Licensing record; disclosure
25 26 27	1. Public information. The following information shall be available to the public, except as otherwise provided by law:
28 29	A. The application and any supporting documentation, except for mental health evaluations;
30 31	B. The department's decision with respect to any application;

- C. Whether a person, firm, corporation or association is or has been licensed, approved or registered in accordance with Subtitle 6;
 - D. The type of license;

- E. The term of the license;
- F. The maximum number of persons for which the facility has been licensed or approved and the number of persons currently placed by the department in that facility, if known;
- 10 G. Whether any administrative hearing or court action has ever been initiated;
- 12 H. The findings and order of any administrative 13 hearing officer or court regarding any applica-14 tion, license, approvals or registrations; and
- I. Whether any complaints have been received by the department regarding an applicant or a person who is licensed, approved or registered, the general nature of the complaint without divulging specific details and what action has been taken by the department, a hearing officer or a court with respect to these complaints.
- 22 2. Confidential information. Without a court or23 der or a written release from the person about whom
 24 the information has been requested, any information,
 25 not referred to in subsection 1, which is contained
 26 in a licensing record, is confidential, and relevant
 27 information may be released only to the following
 28 persons:
- A. A law enforcement agency or other agency investigating reports of adult or child abuse or neglect, whether in or out of State;
- 32 B. An advocacy agency conducting an investiga-33 tion under chapter 961;
- C. A person named in the record or the parent,
 custodian or guardian of a person named in the
 record, provided that the identity of references,
 complainants or other persons is protected when
 appropriate; or

1 2 3 4	D. Any agency involved in approving homes for the placement of children or adults with protection for identity or references, complainants or other persons, when appropriate.
5 6 7 8 9	3. Protective investigations. Except as provided in subsection 1, disclosure of any information gathered as a result of a report or investigation of neglect or abuse in a facility which is licensed, approved or registered pursuant to Subtitle 6 shall be governed by sections 3474 and 4008.
11	STATEMENT OF FACT
12 13 14 15	The purpose of this bill is to clarify what information will and will not be available to the public regarding any records of licensure of any adult or child care facility or program.
16 17 18 19	It is the intent of this bill to make clear that any information gathered in connection with an adult or child protective investigation of any type not be released, except as provided within this bill.
