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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1504,

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L.D. 1980, Bill, "AN ACT to Exempt Certain Materials
that have no Insurable Value from Insurance Require-
ments."

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Amend the bill in that part designated "§2708."
in the first paragraph, in the 3rd line (page 1, line
29 in L.D.) by inserting before the underlined word
"covering" the underlined words 'subject to this
chapter and the bureau shall not issue a permit'

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Further amend the bill in that part designated
"§2708." in the first paragraph, in the 18th line
(page 2, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the under-
lined words and punctuation "and hogged fuel," and
inserting in their place the following: 'or hogged
fuel is not required to provide cargo insurance. Any
person, firm or corporation'

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Further amend the bill in that part designated
"§2708." in the 3rd line from the end (page 2, line
12 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word
"State" the underlined words 'or between points with-
out the State'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment puts back original language that
was omitted in the original bill. This amendment al-
so clarifies explicitly those commodities intended to
be exempt for cargo insurance requirements.
