1 responsible individuals, which bond shall be approved 2 by the bureau. The insurance policy or bond shall adequately provide for cargo insurance and for the col-3 4 lection of damages for which the holder of a permit 5 may be liable by reason of the operation of any motor 6 vehicle or vehicles subject to the operation of this 7 chapter. Notwithstanding this section, any person, firm or corporation transporting logs or pulpwood, 8 garbage, refuse, sludge, junk or unserviceable vehi-9 cles, manure, wood chips, bark and hogged fuel, 10 11 transporting freight between points within this State 12 and points without the State, but passing through this State, is not required to provide cargo insur-13 14 ance.

STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This bill exempts certain commodities from insur-17 ance requirements which by their nature have no in-18 surable value.
