7 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "**A**" to H.P. 1507, 8 L.D. 1982, Bill, "AN ACT to Authorize a School Ad-9 ministrative District to Reconsider the Use of the 10 Alternative Voting Procedure for the Adoption of its 11 School Budget."

12 Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting 13 clause the following:

14 'Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §1305, first ¶, as enacted by 15 PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is amended to read:

16 If requested by a written petition of at least 17 10% of the number of voters voting in the last guber-18 natorial election in the municipalities within the 19 district, the board of directors shall cause the fol-20 lowing article to be voted on by the voters of the 21 member municipalities.

22 "Shall School Administrative District 23 No....require that the voting at future district 24 budget meetings and special district budget meet-25 ings be done by referendum within each member mu-26 nicipality of the district? Yes No "'

Further amend the bill in section 1, in subsection 4, in the 12th line, (page 2, line 4 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "<u>done</u>" the underlined words 'by referendum'

31 Further amend the bill by renumbering the sec-32 tions to read consecutively.
