- The process for reconsideration may be initiated either by the board of directors or written petition of at least 10% of the number of voters voting in the last gubernatorial election in the municipalities within the district.
 - The procedure for voting on the article for carrying out the election shall be as set forth in this section.
 - C. If the article passes, then the alternative voting procedure will continue to be the process for adopting budgets in the district; if the ticle fails to pass, then future district budgets be adopted in accordance with sections 1303 will and 1304.
- Sec. 2. Reconsideration. Notwithstanding the year limitation set forth in the Revised Statutes, 1305, subsection Title 20-A, section reconsidering the alternative voting procedure, any district which has adopted the alternative voting procedure, prior to the effective date of this Act, may reconsider it under the provisions of section at any time during the calendar year 1984; after January 1, 1985, the 3-year limitation set forth in this Act will apply to all districts which have adopted or may adopt the alternative voting procedure.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill authorizes School Administrative Districts which have adopted the alternative voting procedure for the approval of school budgets to be able reconsider their decisions to adopt their budgets by referendum. Districts would also be authorized to
