19 20 21 22	AN ACT to Authorize a Self-liquidating Bond Issue for York County to Construct an Addition to the York County Jail.
23 24 25	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis- lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
26 27 28	Whereas, York County has an immediate need to be- gin construction on the county jail project to ease overcrowding; and
29 30 31	Whereas, undue delay in beginning construction, scheduled to commence in the spring of 1984, will in- crease the cost of the project to the taxpayers; and
32 33 34	Whereas, immediate authorization for the bond is- sue will prevent any unnecessary cost increase and provide immediate relief for overcrowding; and

1 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 2 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 3 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 4 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-5 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 6 therefore,

7 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 8 follows:

9 Sec. 1. Authorization to raise money for addi-10 tion to York County jail. Notwithstanding the Re-11 vised Statutes, Title 30, section 404, the county 12 commissioners of York County are authorized to raise 13 and expend a sum not exceeding \$364,000 for an addi-14 tion to the York County jail.

15 Sec. 2. Aid from other sources. The county com-16 missioners of York County are authorized to borrow 17 any portion of the sums herein authorized from or 18 through any agency or department of the State and of 19 the Federal Government. The county commissioners are 20 authorized to receive grants of money and other also 21 assistance from or through any agency or department 2.2 of the State and Federal Government for any of the 23 purposes authorized in this Act.

24 To provide funds for the Sec. 3. Bonds. addition to the York County jail, the treasurer of York 25 26 County, with the approval of the county commission-27 ers, may borrow from time to time upon the full faith and credit of the county such sums not exceeding in 28 29 the aggregate \$364,000 as may be necessary, and may 30 issue self-liquidating bonds therefor which shall bear on their faces the words "York County Capital 31 Improvement Bonds Act of 1984". 32 Each authorized is-33 sue shall be payable in such installments, beginning 34 not more than 6 months from the date thereof and not 35 earlier than June 30, 1984, as will extinquish each loan in not more than 3 years from its date. 36 The 37 bonds shall be signed by the treasurer of York County 38 and countersigned by a majority of the county commis-39 The county may sell sioners. these securities at 40 public or private sale upon such terms and conditions 41 as the county commissioners deem proper, but not less than par and accrued interest. These bonds shall be 42

voted without first obtaining the consent of that
county as provided in the Revised Statutes, Title 30,
section 404.

4 Sec. 4. 1982 unexpended surplus. Notwith-5 standing the Revised Statutues, Title 30, section 6 408, the county commissioners of York County are au-7 thorized to spend \$75,000 of the unexpended 1982 sur-8 plus for the addition to the York County jail.

9 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency 10 cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect 11 when approved.

## 12 STATEMENT OF FACT

13 The intent of this bill is fully stated in the 14 emergency preamble.
