AN ACT to Establish the Cost of the 1984
Spruce Budworm Suppression Project.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
lature do not become effective until 90 days after
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, prompt determination of the cost of the
Spruce Budworm Spray Project is necessary in order to
establish preproject taxes to be assessed on landown-
ers in the spray program area; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
the Constitution of Maine and require the following
legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:
