11 weir fishing needed to maintain the weir owner's li-  
12 cense;

13 3. Allow a weir owner to undress his weir in an-  
14 ticipation of bad weather without losing his license;

16 4. Repeal the closed season on purse seining in  
17 Washington County.

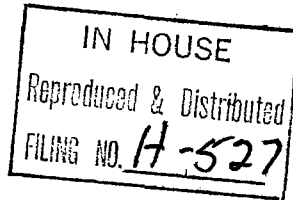
