AN ACT to Prohibit Night Scallop Dragging
within the 3-mile Limit in Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

12 MRSA §6726 is enacted to read:

§6726. Night-time scallop dragging in Washington County prohibited

It is unlawful to fish for or take scallops with scallop drags from 1/2 hour after sunset until 1/2 hour before sunrise the following day within 3 miles of the coastline in the coastal waters of Washington County.
