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**AN ACT to Increase the Enforcement  
and Educational Staff of the Maine Land Use  
Regulation Commission.**

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**Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the operation of the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission will become due and payable on or immediately after July 1, 1984; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-

1 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,  
2 therefore,

3 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
4 follows:

5 **Appropriation.** The following funds are appropri-  
6 ated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes  
7 of this Act.

20 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-  
21 proved.

22 STATEMENT OF FACT

23 This bill transfers \$20,819 from the Maine Land  
24 Use Regulation Commission's All Other account to Per-  
25 sonal Services and appropriates an additional \$36,844  
26 to provide 3 additional positions to enforce Maine  
27 Land Use Regulation Commission regulations, check  
28 compliance with Maine Land Use Regulation Commission  
29 permits and educate landowners and others involved in  
30 management and development of the unorganized terri-  
31 tories.

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
